Recent Council Actions



At its July 18, 2011 meeting, the City Council took the following actions:

- Awarded the bid for the Buffalo Lane Reconstruction Project to C.W. Houle, Inc. in the amount of \$249,006.20. This project includes reconstruction of the street with concrete curb and gutter and a modern storm drainage system, and installation of water and sanitary sewer service to a few properties on this street, which is located off of Lexington Avenue near Hamline Avenue.
- Adopted electric and gas franchise ordinances that grant permission to Xcel Energy to operate its electric and gas utilities in Shoreview for the next 20 years. The current franchise ordinances expire in August.
- Approved a quote from Ellingson Companies to install a watermain from Tomlyn Avenue to just south of Carmel Court. The cost of this project is \$72,521.60.
- Appointed Jeff Tarnowski to the Public Safety Committee for a term ending January 31, 2013.

Slice of Shoreview - "It's Doggone Fun"

The 2011 Slice of Shoreview will be held this weekend at Island Lake Park. This year's theme is "It's Doggone Fun" and includes a return of the popular dock dogs, as well as standard Slice activities such as the Arts & Crafts fair, carnival, food court area, and musical entertainment. Fireworks will be held on both Friday and Saturday nights. The JimTones are the featured entertainment on Friday night and the Rockin' Hollywoods will play on Saturday night. Riders begin between 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. in the Deluxe Corporation parking lot across from Island Lake Park. Riders can usually finish the ride in time for the Slice of Shoreview parade at 10:00 a.m. The cost is \$7.00 per rider or \$20 for the family and includes a t-shirt. Bike helmets are required. City Water Restrictions May 15 - September 15

Summer water use restrictions will remain in effect through September 15. Residents with even numbered houses (last digit of house address) can water lawns on even

number calendar days, odd numbered houses on odd number calendar days.

These restrictions do not apply to properties that use a private well for watering purposes, or for water uses including car washing, filling of children's swimming pools, children playing in a hose operated sprinkler or water toy, or hand-held watering of plants and shrubs.

Residents with newly sodded or seeded yards may obtain an exemption from the odd-even restriction for a period of two weeks. Residents requiring an exemption should contact the Shoreview Public Works Department at 651.490.4650.
