Recent Council Actions from June 17 Meeting

- Accepted the bid from North Valley, Inc. for the 2013 Street Rehabilitation and Gaston, Grove St. Albans Watermain Extension project in the amount of \$3.3 million. The rehabilitation of the parking lots at Wilson and McCullough Parks are also included in this project.
- Accepted the bid from Allied Blacktop Company for the 2013 Street Sealcoating project in the amount of \$233,974. The project is anticipated to start late June and take about three days of application.
