Recent Council Actions

At their regular Council meeting on Monday, May 21, the City Council took the following actions:

- Approved a bid award for the 2012 Street Renewal project in the Floral Drive, County Road F, Demar Avenue area with C.W. Houle Inc. in the amount of \$1,215,939. This street reconstruction project will begin in June and is expected to be completed in early fall.
- Authorized the preparation of a feasibility study for potential improvements to Red Fox Road, located just south of I-694 east of Lexington Avenue. Red Fox Road serves as the primary access to Super Target and the new Stonehenge Retail Center that is currently under construction. The Stonehenge Retail Center will include a Chipotle and LeeAnn Chin restaurants and a Sports Clips.


