Council Actions from October 15 meeting

At its October 15th meeting, the City Council took the following actions:

- Approved a rezoning, planned unit development and preliminary plat for a four lot, single family residential development at 5618 Heather Ridge Court. The existing home will remain on a 6.5 acre parcel, and three new lots ranging from about 1.5 to 2.0 acres were created as part of this development.
- Approved an additional \$100,000 in tax increment assistance to TSI, Inc., 500 Cardigan Road, for drainage improvement on their site. TSI is constructing a 57,000 square foot addition to their building and adding parking to accommodate as many as 180 new jobs over the next several years.

Hydrant Flushing Continues

City Utility Maintenance Crews are continuing their biannual hydrant flushing program through the end of October to clean sediment from water mains and insure proper operation of hydrants and valves.



During the hydrant flushing process, residents may notice reduced water pressure and some discoloration of the water for a short period of time. Although there is no health hazard associated with the discolored water, residents are encouraged to run cold water through their taps until the water is clear. It is also suggested that residents avoid doing laundry (particularly whites) while the hydrants are being flushed or water is discolored.
