Recent Council Actions from October 7 Meeting

- Approved the minor subdivision, 5107 Alameda Street, which divides the property into two parcels for single-family residential development.
- Approved the Site and Building Plan Review application submitted by Kaas Wilson Architects for the Lakeshore Oaks Apartment complex at 525 Harriet Avenue. Some of the improvements include, but are not limited to:
 - Fire pit, grills, outdoor seating and amenities
 - Addition of rain gardens and landscape plantings
 - Community Center building addition
 - New cabinets, kitchen appliances, bath fixtures and floor coverings in 40-60 apartments
 - Remodel corridors, security system, laundries and stairs in some building
