Construction is Starting Soon!

- In the next few weeks, the contractor for the project will start the installation of a temporary water system that will provide your home with water while the existing water main is replaced. The temporary water line is typically connected to an outside spigot. Once the temporary water system is on-line the contractor will start the replacement of the water main.

Check Your Doors for Notices

- Residents should check their doors daily for specific information regarding work occurring on the project. Work that requires immediate notice will be posted on your door.

Schedules May Change on Short Notice

- Weather, delays by subcontractors, or other unforeseen events can cause schedule changes. The Engineering Department and the City contractor will do their best to keep residents notified if schedules change.

Work Zone Safety


- Due to heavy equipment traffic and general construction activity, we ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of the construction sites. Your support and cooperation in assisting us to maintain a safe work zone is appreciated.

Water Main Replacement & Sanitary Sewer Cleanouts

- As part of the project your water service line will be replaced from the mainline pipe, located under the street, to the property line. Cleanouts will also be installed on your sanitary sewer service at the property line. If there is a conflict with current trees, the project representative will be contacting you regarding possible options.

RIGHT-OF-WAY

Personal Systems and Landscaping in the Right-of-Way

Many homeowners have installed irrigation systems, invisible fencing and other landscape items adjacent to the street. Because these private irrigation systems, fence systems, and landscape items are within the City street Right-of-Way (ROW); they are potentially in the path of the reconstruction project and must be moved.

Homeowners are responsible for temporarily moving or relocating their own systems. This work should be taken care of before crews start working on your street. The Engineering Department suggests that you remove your sprinkler heads and plug lines that are located within 5-feet of the existing street and pull the pipe ends up or mark them in some way so they can be easily seen. You will still be responsible for repairing any irrigation or fencing systems you have placed within the ROW, but these suggestions will minimize costs for replacing the systems later.

Parking Restrictions

Once the construction starts, it is important that **all vehicles be removed from the roadway between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm**. Even though you may not see construction equipment on-site, work will be ongoing and schedules can change quickly.



Garbage and Recycling

Your garbage and recycling will be picked up as scheduled. Please continue to have your garbage and recycling curbside by 7:00 am on your regularly scheduled pickup day. If the collection trucks are unable to drive down the street the contractor will move the carts to an area where they can be accessed and return the cart to your driveway. Please write your house address on your carts so they can be returned to the right property.



Why are there spray paint markings in my yard?

The City as well as various utility contractors and companies locate where the underground utilities might be buried before the excavation begins to protect your property against underground utility damage.



Temporary Mailboxes

Temporary mailboxes will be installed prior to construction in locations that are determined by the Post Office. The Post Office will provide you with information regarding the temporary location before moving your mailbox. A separate temporary mailbox will be provided for each homeowner with the address clearly labeled. If you are concerned about the security of your mail, you may have it held at the Post Office and pick it up there.

Your letter carrier will make the determination as to when to switch delivery to the temporary mailboxes. Please check both your permanent mailbox and the temporary mailbox to ensure that you are receiving your mail. Once delivery has changed to the temporary mailboxes, the contractor will remove your permanent mailbox and place it in your yard, outside the construction limits. Please store your mailbox until they are ready to be reinstalled near the end of the project. If you encounter any problems with your mail delivery, please contact your local Post Office.

Xcel Energy

Xcel Energy will be installing new gas lines within the project area. As they install the new gas lines, some disturbances will occur to your street and boulevard areas. Xcel will contact you individually with regard to your gas service. Please be aware that they will be televising your sanitary sewer service after installation is complete, as required to by State law. If you have any questions or concerns about the installation, please contact Xcel at 800-895-2999.

You'll know what's below by the different flags, stakes or paint.

-  **Red** - Electric
-  **Yellow** - Gas, oil or petroleum
-  **Orange** - Communications
-  **Blue** - Potable water
-  **Purple** - Reclaimed water, irrigation
-  **Green** - Sewer
-  **White** - Proposed excavation
-  **Pink** - Temporary survey
